# Policy Board Meeting May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023 @ 10:00 AM MINUTES

## A. ROLL CALL

Mr. Derrick Harris, MPO Study Director, called the meeting to order by officially confirming everyone present at the meeting. The following Policy Board members were present: (Quorum = 51% = 6 committee members; must include at least three (3) elected officials)

# **B. ACTION ITEMS**

- 1) Minutes February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023 The committee reviewed the minutes as presented. Mr. Farmahan made a motion to approve the minutes; the motion was seconded by Mr. Fields. The item passed unanimously.
- 2) FY 2024 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Mr. Harris presented the final Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 UPWP for approval. Mr. Harris mentioned how this underwent a two-week public comment period, with no comments submitted. Mr. Mahoney made a motion to approve the motion as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Lipton. The item passed unanimously.
- 3) Performance Measures (PM) 2 & 3 Staff from the Arkansas Department of Transportation presented on the proposed statewide targets for PM 2 and PM 3. These correspond to Bridge and Pavement condition, and Travel Time Reliability. Mr. Mahoney made a motion to approve the item as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Caverly. The item passed unanimously.

- 4) FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment Mr. Harris presented a TIP Amendment to amend our current TIP to include the intersection improvement project at the convergence of Higdon Ferry and Central Avenue in front of Oaklawn Racing Resort and Casino. Mr. Harris highlighted how this project isn't currently in the TIP and is a requirement to receive federal funds. Mr. Mahoney made a motion to approve the amendment as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Fields. The item passed unanimously.
- 5) 2023 Short-Range Project List Mr. Harris presented the project list and discussed how the list was created. He highlighted that these projects would be the ones submitted to the Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) for consideration into the next Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Some discussion ensued, but the project list remained the same. Joint consensus on the project list.

## C. MPO REPORTS/ANNOUNCEMENTS

Mr. Harris informed the committee that the Hot Springs Urbanized Area would be getting a newly formed pot of money for reducing the carbon footprint in our area. This Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) could be utilized for trails, transit, electric vehicle infrastructure, etc..., and wanted to gain committee feedback on best use cases. The committee overwhelming agreed, that trails would be the best use of those funds.
